Starved Rock State Park Campground is set in a semi-wooded area with 133 Class A campsites and is open every day of the year. **100 sites (including 2 handicap sites) can be reserved (Sites 31-55 & 59-133) for the period of May - October.** Reservations for these sites will be accepted through **ReserveAmerica.com** beginning **July 7, 2010**. We strongly encourage making a reservation since our campground is usually full May - October. There are 30 sites (including 5 handicap sites) available on a first-come-first-serve basis which usually fill up every weekend.

Starved Rock State Park Campground is maintained to provide camping in a natural setting as part of the outdoor recreational experience. Each campsite has electricity, a gravel parking space, a picnic table, and a metal burn grill. We hope you have an enjoyable visit at Starved Rock State Park. Regulations are only common sense and designed for your safety and to protect the park environment. Traffic barriers allow emergency exits only.

- **Alcohol is always prohibited in the campground & on the trails. It is banned on the rest of the property from January 1st through May 31st.**
- **You must be 18 years old to camp unless accompanied by a parent.**
- **There is a maximum of 1 family (2 parents with their minor children) or four individuals per site with 2 tents.**
- **Camping permits must be displayed on the adjacent post that designates the campsite number. All vehicles must park on gravel pads. All tents must be erected within 15 feet of the gravel pad.**
- **Quiet hours: 10 p.m. - 7 a.m. The campground gates are locked at 10:00 pm.**
- **This area is not for parties or other noisy nighttime activities.**
- **All pets must be on a leash and attended at all times and you must pick up after them.**
- **Ground fires are not allowed.**
- **NO wood may be collected for fires within the park. Fallen trees and branches become animal's homes, nests and food.**
- **Those individuals who violate park rules, particularly regarding noise levels, alcoholic beverage consumption, and closing hours will be arrested and/or evicted**
- **A reservation will be held until 3:00 pm of the day following the first night's reservation.**
- **Reservations will be accepted for the period of MAY-OCTOBER beginning January 2nd.**
- **Reservation fee will not be refunded or transferred.**
- **A reservation and camping fee must be received by the Park seven days in advance.**
- **YOUTH GROUPS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO CAMP IN THE REGULAR CAMPGROUND.** The only way this is allowed is if you are camping as a family unit.
