Illinois Department of Natural Resources 2012 Non-Resident Archery Deer Hunt Application

Applications will be accepted until close of business on March 31st, 2012. On April 2nd at 8 am a random drawing will commence to select successful applicants. Applicants will be notified with the results of the drawing as soon as possible. Please do not call the office to receive results of the drawing.

Please type or print your applications. Applications that are not legible will be discarded.

Up to three partners will be considered if indicated on the application; however, this application will also be considered the partner's official application. If any hunter's name appears on more than one application, the applications will be rejected. Mail only one application per envelope. All applications must be received in a sealed envelope marked "Non-Resident Archery Deer Hunt".

To be eligible to hunt, you must have in your possession a valid Illinois Archery Deer Permit, a Non-Resident Hunting License, and Habitat Stamp. Information on the availability of these will be available on DNR's Web Site in the future.

Statewide hunting regulations will be in effect, including the following site specific rules:

- 1. No hunting will be permitted within 100 yards of any developed area.**
- 2. Tree stands must be portable. Screw in steps are not allowed.**
- 3. All three hunting areas are quality deer management areas. Only antler-less deer or antlered deer having at least four points on one side may be harvested.**
- 4. Permits are not transferrable.**
- 5. At Sangchris Lake State Park hunters must harvest a doe first, before they can harvest a buck.**
