Ambystoma talpoideum (mole salamander)	swamp
Cryptobranchus alleganiensis (hellbender)	swift rivers, streams
Desmognathus conanti (spotted dusky salamander)	cool headwaters, forest
Gastrophryne carolinensis (eastern narrowmouth toad)	open floodplains, ephemeral pools
Hemidactylium scutatum (four-toed salamander)	pools, streams, forest
Hyla avivoca (bird-voiced treefrog)	swamp
Necturus maculosus (mudpuppy)	gravel-bottom streams, lakes
Pseudacris streckeri illinoensis (Illinois chorus frog)	sand prairie, ephemeral pools
Rana areolata (crayfish frog)	wet grasslands, ephemeral pools
Rana palustris (pickerel frog)	cool, rocky headwaters, cave entrances
Rana sylvatica (wood frog)	forest, ephemeral pools

Apalone mutica (smooth softshell turtle)	sand-bottom streams
Clemmys guttata (spotted turtle)	marsh
Clonophis kirtlandii (Kirtland's snake)	wet grassland, marsh
Crotalus horridus (timber rattlesnake)	forest, rocky slopes
Elaphe emoryi (great plains rat snake)	rocky grassland/savanna slopes
Emydoidea blandingii (Blanding's turtle)	marsh
Farancia abacura (mud snake)	swamp
Heterodon nasicus (western hognose snake)	sand prairie, sand savanna
Kinosternon flavescens (Illinois mud turtle)	wetlands in sand prairie
Kinosternon subrubrum (eastern mud turtle)	swamp
Macrochelys temminckii (alligator snapping turtle)	rivers, swamp
Masticophis flagellum (coachwhip)	rocky grassland/savanna slopes

Nerodia cyclopion (Mississippi green water snake)	swamp
Nerodia erythrogaster neglecta (n. copperbelly watersnake)	swamp, bottomland forest
Nerodia fasciata (broad-banded water snake)	swamp
Liochlorophis vernalis (smooth green snake)	grassland, savanna, marsh, successional
Ophisaurus attenuatus (slender glass lizard)	grassland, savanna
Pseudemys concinna (river cooter)	rivers, swamp
Sistrurus catenatus catenatus (eastern massasauga)	marsh, bottomland forest, grassland
Tantilla gracilis (flathead snake)	rocky, wooded slopes
Terrapene ornata (ornate box turtle)	grassland
Thamnophis sauritus (eastern ribbon snake)	bottomland forest, swamp
Tropidoclonion lineatum (lined snake)	grassland
