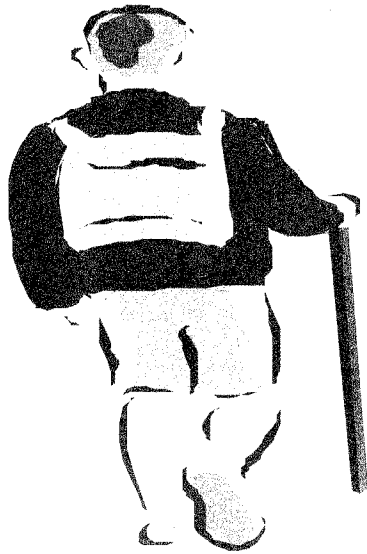

Trail Descriptions:

- * **Whispering Pines**
 - ^ Length: 1.75 Miles
 - ^ Difficulty: Moderate
 - Goes through nature preserve
- * **Woodpecker**
 - ^ Length: 1.00 Mile
 - ^ Difficulty: Slight
 - Great lake overlooks
- * **Observatory**
 - ^ Length: 2.35 Miles
 - ^ Difficulty: Moderate
 - ^ Starts from Whispering Pines Trail
 - Rolling terrain and bottomlands
 - Bottomlands subject to river flooding
 - * Closed during Archery Deer Season
- * **Gray Squirrel -to- Twin Points**
 - ^ Length: .5 Mile
 - ^ Difficulty: Moderate
 - Connection for 3 mile exercise loop
