

DISABLED HUNTERS: If selected, you will be able to bring up to three (3) guests to assist you. You may list an alternate only if the alternate also qualifies with a P2A disability. The guests may also hunt and do not have to be disabled. The disabled permit holder, or qualified alternate, must be present at all times.

NON-HANDICAPPED HUNTERS: You may also bring three (3) hunting guests. You may list an alternate permit holder. You or your alternate must be present at all times for the party to hunt. No more than four (4) people may hunt and no guests may be substituted for someone who has to leave or who has harvested their limit of birds during the same day.

Any hunter confined to a wheelchair, or unable to retrieve his / her own downed birds, **MUST** bring at least one (1) other guest to assist them. No assistance will be provided by the Clinton Lake State Recreation Area site personnel.

All qualified handicapped individuals will be considered first. Each qualified handicapped applicant will get two (2) dates before non-handicapped hunters will be chosen. If dates are still available after all handicapped individuals are drawn, then non-handicapped hunters will be considered for the open dates. Successful applicants will be sent a map and fact sheet along with the permit.

Submit a current copy of Proof of Disability with your application (Driver's License or Disability Card) that shows you have a Class P 2 A disability if you are applying as a handicapped hunter or alternate handicapped permit holder.

All non-handicapped applicants must also include a photocopy of your 2011 - 2012 hunting license and your alternate's hunting license, if you are listing an alternate.
