3. Fees: Pointing Breed Field Trials, Horseback Fox Hound, Retrieving Breed & Flushing Breed Field Trials - \$70.00 per day; Beagle and Coon Hound Field Trials - \$25.00 per day
4. A certificate of liability insurance valid for the dates of the field trial must either be on file with the DNR or attached to this application.
5. Handlers, scouts and gunners are required to have a valid Illinois Hunting or Sportsmen's License and Habitat Stamp. Field trial organizations may request waivers in writing for non-resident handlers, scouts and gunners.
