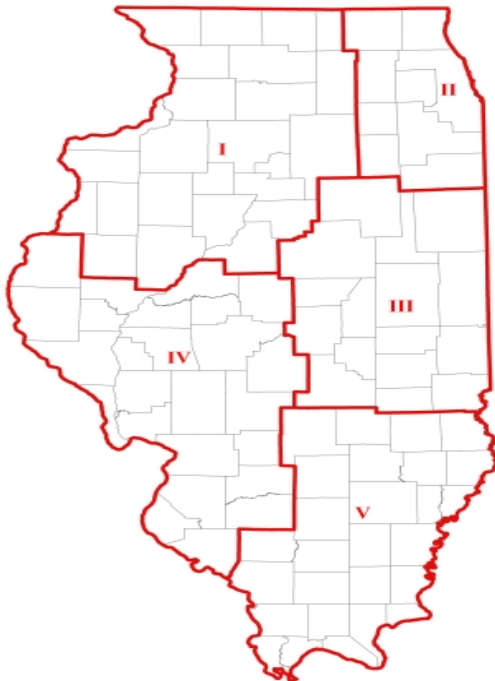


# Salvage/Road Kill Deer Reporting System

**SALVAGE:** Any individual finding a dead or injured deer, other than those killed in a vehicle-deer collision or legally taken by hunting methods, shall not move, transport or take possession of the deer parts until permission is obtained from a Conservation Police Officer or the IDNR Regional Law Enforcement Office.

**COLLECTION OF SHED ANTLERS:** Shed antlers may not be collected from any State Park, dedicated Nature Preserve, or buffer area. Shed antlers collected from other areas are not considered “Salvage” and are not required to be reported.

**ROAD KILL:** Road kill deer may only be claimed by persons who are residents of Illinois, are not delinquent in child support payments and do not have their wildlife privileges suspended in any state. Individuals who claim a deer killed in a vehicle collision shall report the possession of the road-kill deer to the Department of by submitting a report to the IDNR within 24 hours by using the following link to the on-line [Road Kill Deer Reporting Form](#) or by telephoning the Department of Natural Resources at (217) 782-6431 no later than 4:30 p.m. on the next business day.
